## **First Semester Education Requirements**

- Estimated time spent each week: Between 5-7 hours required per week
- Participate in New Member Welcome Event (Week of 1/14/24)
- Attend 6 weeks of New Member Education sessions on the following topics:
  - Week of 1/21/24: Introduction to Lion Ambassadors
  - Week of 1/28/24: Professional Development
  - Week of 2/4/24: Touring
  - Week of 2/11/24: Projects & Event Planning
  - Week of 2/18/24: Serving as an Ambassador
  - Week of 2/25/24: Exam & Conclusion
    - All New Members are required to complete and pass an assessment at the conclusion of New Member Education.
  - o Mid-March: New Member Reception

- Members will assume the full responsibilities of a Lion Ambassador as detailed below following the conclusion of New Member Education

- Estimated time spent each week: Minimum of 4 hours per week
- Attend general body and project planning meetings once per week
- Volunteer at Lion Ambassador projects throughout the year
- Lead a minimum of 2 private tours per semester
- Give private tours and attend special events hosted by the Penn State Alumni Association
- Complete semesterly initiatives focused on service, DEIB, and professional development
- Abide by Penn State's Student Code of Conduct and the Lion Ambassadors' Standards of Excellence
